



According to Peirce's Pragmatism, the epistemological understanding of reality, which is basic for human knowledge, consists of an unlimited process of investigation. In each instance of this process investigators can treat only questions of a necessarily restricted nature which heavily rely on common sense, on views and purposes with respect to the considered realities. Therefore human knowledge is always incomplete and continuously requires intersub'ective communication and fumentation for its formation.
